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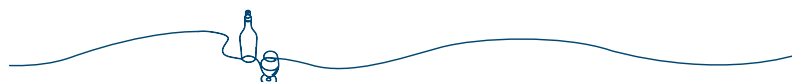

Biggest producer of Malbec in the world.



Over 60% of Argentine wine is grown in the Mendoza region.



Some vineyards are 3000m above sea level causing slower ripening grapes with more freshness and acidity in the wines.

Wine production in Argentina dates back to the 16th century when Spanish colonisers brought vines with them to the region. Today, the vineyards of Argentina cover 220 000 hectares across different regions each producing widely different wines and styles to explore.

In the colder South of these wine regions, you will find wines with higher acidity and lighter fruit. These regions are known for great Pinot Noir and Sauvignon Blanc. While, in the warmer North, you often find full-bodied, structured Malbec and Chardonnay.

Argentina is the fifth largest wine producer in the world after Italy, France, Spain and the USA. The main producing region is the province of Mendoza producing more than 60% of the Argentinian wine, followed by the provinces of San Juan and La Rioja, and then Salta, Tucumán, Catamarca, La Pampa and Rio Negro.

As the 2nd largest wine producing region of Argentina, San Juan accounts for around 20% of the total wine production. The region is located in west-central Argentina and right on the foot of the Andes Mountains, which supplies the dry region with meltwater.

ARGENTINA

Malbec

Originally a French grape, Malbec was brought to South America by French immigrants in the 19th century. It is now one of Argentina's signature grapes and particularly thrives in high elevation areas, such as San Juan which is mostly 640m (2,100 ft) above sea level.

Extremely popular, Malbec represents approximately 40% of the total red wine produced in Argentina. Malbec wines are loved for their rich, dark fruit flavours and smooth chocolatey finish. Dry, full body and medium tannins combine to make Malbec perfect to pair with leaner red meats and melted blue cheese.

Home to some of the oldest vines in the world. The oldest in Australia is in Barossa Valley, Planted in 1843.

Full-bodied Shiraz, oaky Chardonnay, fresh Sauvignon Blanc, and tannic Cabernet Sauvignon. These are just a few of the many styles and grape varieties you find in Australia. The country is mostly affected by the warm climate although some regions like Tasmania experience a much colder climate. In 2014 there was an almost equal amount of red and white wine but the latest years have seen a tendency in more production of red wine. In the vintage of 2022, the percentage of white grapes crushed was 45%.

The main grape in Australia is Shiraz, which in other countries is known as Syrah. While Syrah is best known for the wines of Cote-Rotie and Hermitage, Shiraz produces wines with more body and dark fruit in Australia. These wines are often easy to drink and pair well with most sorts of food. Maybe that is the reason why 45% of red grapes in Australia are Shiraz.

Although the general value of the grapes has fallen the quality of the grapes has not. Even though many winemakers report massive rainfalls and wildfires across the country they seem to have overcome the challenges once again. In general, the quality is consistently high but we are looking at a cooler vintage overall.

Tropical fruits, apple and pear on the palate with a delicate creamy texture and a crisp clean finish.

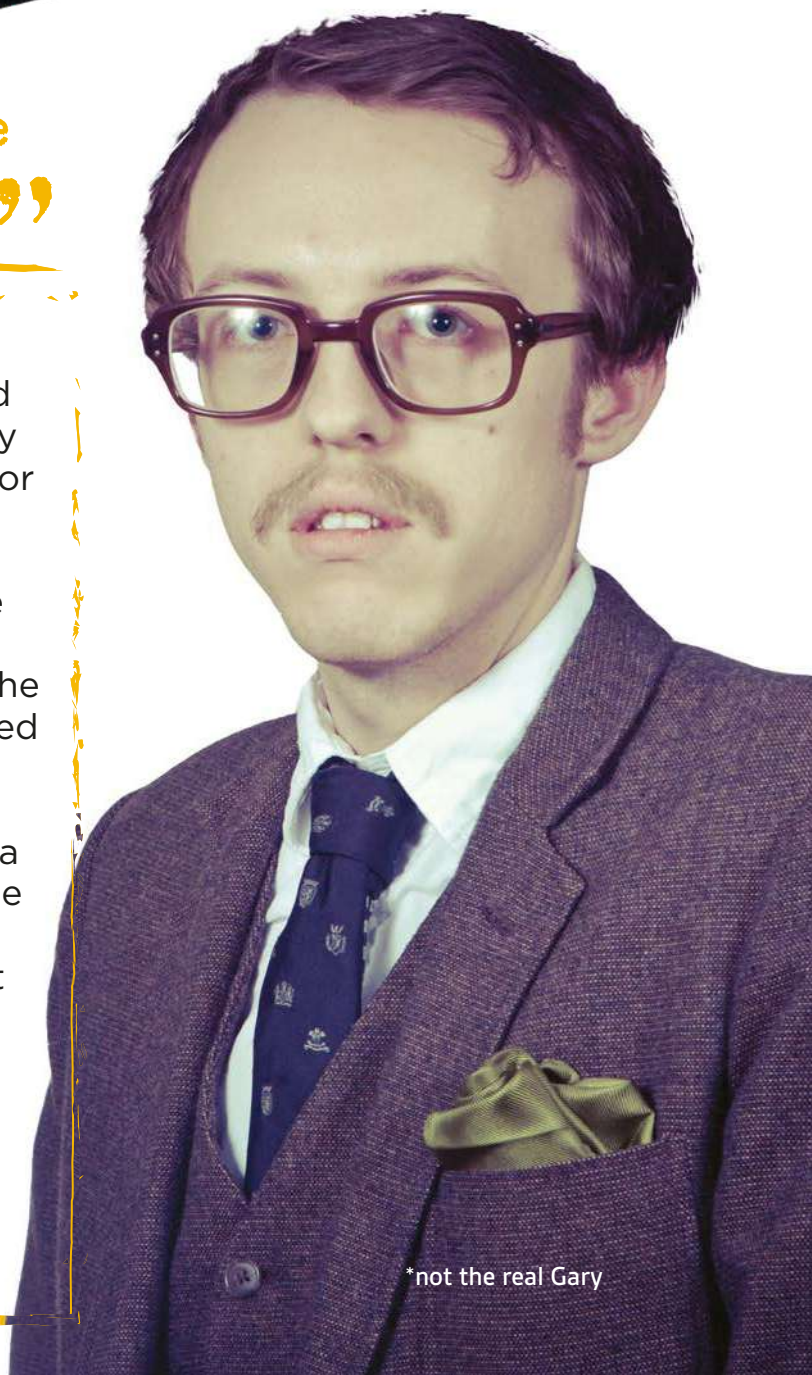

What was the inspiration for the Bella Luna range?

The Bella Luna story came from the McPherson vineyards in the first years of the new century, when a lovely picker named Edo (Eduardo) from Rome came to work with the team and would testify to Jo (Jo Nash, McPherson winemaker) about the joys of the Italian varietals. After working with Jo for some time and sampling many bottles, Edo convinced Jo that it would be worth planting just one vineyard of Fiano and Nero d'Avola and, finally, she agreed.

There was just one hitch.... Edo insisted the vines needed to be planted on the night of the full moon. He told her planting in this way has been practiced since ancient times and it would make all the difference to the resulting grapes if the vines were planted under the "Bella Luna".

Now, Jo is a practical person however, Edo is even more persuasive than Jo is practical, so somehow Jo found herself overseeing a full moon planting of the vines that would grow the grapes for our Bella Luna wines.

We will never know if the beautiful moon on the night of the planting made a difference to the wine but we like to think it did, and we do feel there's magic in that bottle.



Nuovi classici.

Australian winemakers have been experimenting with Italian grape varieties over the last several years. Some of these experiments started with climate change in mind, but several winemakers have also long held the view that certain Australian climates were already a good natural fit for the sun-loving varieties of southern Italy, in particular.

When you think about it, this rise of the Aussie Italians makes sense; the Mediterranean climate of much of south-east Australia is ideally suited for Italian grape varieties. However, these wines aren't strictly the Italian classics we're used to. While the Australian climate may be similar, the terroir creates a different depth of character, profile and aroma. Rather, these Australian Italian wines are an 'interpretation'; these winemakers are creating a new style of wine whilst maintaining the characteristics of the grape.

There has been with a shift towards more savoury flavoured wines, partly in rebellion to the fruit bombs of the past, partly due to food culture which has seen a rise in attention to good food. Wines that are more on the savoury side with more acidity and structure, like those produced from these Italian grape varieties, are generally more food-friendly.

And, of course Australian wine regulations are not as strict as those of Europe, for example; so there is no restriction on which varieties may be planted or indeed where they may be planted. Indeed, Australia's wine industry has a history of experimentation, not afraid to dig up swathes of vineyards to respond to changes in taste or in climate.

Meet the Winemaker - Jo Nash

Jo graduated from Charles Stuart university and began her career under Andrew McPherson's tutelage at the family-owned winery, becoming head winemaker in 2011.

She is perhaps best known for Don't Tell Gary, a wine she first made by quietly passing the annual budget set by the winery's general manager, the eponymous Gary.

McPherson is very much like a family. When you're in the winery everyone is working together, everyone is appreciated, everyone has a part to play. It's certainly not a hierarchical structure, it's a warm family environment where everyone comes to work and does a great job. I'd extend that to the sales and marketing team too.

Andrew McPherson is lovely; he's like a big teddy bear. He's really gruff on the outside but warm and lovely on the inside. We certainly had our differences of opinion over the years but we worked collaboratively and we got the end results we wanted. He was great. In the early years he was there as much as I needed him to be and then he allowed me to step up and put my fingerprint on the wine and the winemaking styles.

The philosophy for me has always been, why interfere with the style of the fruit? Let the fruit do the talking and let the wine speak for itself, so whether we are making a commercial wine or a premium wine or anything in between, it's really important that stylistically you put your nose in the glass and you're like, "yep, it's a fruit-driven style, it's fresh, the wine's in balance".

The guys work so hard out there in the vineyards and there are so many challenges. So it's important we capture all of that work.

I'm really lucky in that we're located in central Victoria and we get to draw fruit from various regions surrounding us. So not only do we look at central Victoria in terms of Strathbogie Ranges and Heathcote up to Dookie but we move out to places like the King Valley and towards the Yarra.

So there are so many different regions that we actually get to be involved with, which is fantastic, because all the regions have their own nuances.

I've never been a big fan of American oak, it's always been French for me. It's much more delicate and integrates a whole lot better with the wine. There's nothing more romantic than a French oak 500-litre puncheon that's brand new. If you're fermenting Chardonnay and you stick your nose in the barrel it's just the most amazing thing you've ever smelled.

I have a love/hate relationship with vintage. Every year before you head into it you're thinking, "goodness, here we go again", but once you're into it it's just the most amazing thing. The winery is full of aromas and the team just comes together.

We're very busy and a very small team but we are all conscious that we have to have a good time. When you're mid-vintage and working 12 hours a day, six days a week, or longer, if you can't have a laugh, then what's it all about? We keep a sense of humour and we don't take ourselves too seriously and I think that's been part of the success of the business. We are making this wine with this crew of people, and people on the other side of the world are enjoying it. That's what we do it for. That's what gets me out of bed.

Terry explains: "The most important part of our business - apart from being deadly serious about what's in the bottle and what's in the glass - is that we are trying to have fun. Everything is very light-hearted about the way we bring Plan B! Wines to the market. We're trying to do it with a sense of humour and something that's going to be memorable for everyone who drinks our wines. The wines offer great drinking and are really great bang for buck!"

We asked Terry to talk us through his wines...

Plan B 'DR' Riesling 2021/22

Great Southern

Vibrant aromatics of lemon and lime blossom with talc and minerality.

The palate is generous showing great persistence of soft citrus and textural weight leading to a long and structured finish and length without undue austerity.

It's a riot of semi-sweet freshness and citrusy zing. Serious at the front but there's a party going on out the back. It's an Angelic Germanic!

After 1985 when Austria experienced the glycol scandal the quality of the wines have been continuously rising. With the toughest wine laws of the world and a unique climate the country might be one of the most exciting to follow in the next decade. The star of the country is called Grüner Veltliner and you can find the grape variety in all wine growing areas in Austria.

2022 in Austria was very promising with a dry summer and perfect ripening. Despite the expected high quality, yields were slightly lower than usual. With 2,460,275 Hl recorded in 2021 the total wine production from Austria is quite low compared to other countries. With 2020 and 2021 being vintages with record high acidity it seems that the acidity of vintage 2022 has returned to normal standards. This will please wine lovers who like more easy drinking wines with more complexity.

Grüner Veltliner is by far the most planted grape variety with approximately a third of the total vineyards planted with the famous white grape.

The capital of Austria, Vienna has its own wine region. When travelling from the airport to the city you actually see several vineyards around on the slopes.

Part of the famous Matetic business, Ventopuro's aim is to make wines that tell the story of where they come from. But, the producer also feels a responsibility to support the people and the environment of rural Chile.

We asked Juan José San Martín from Ventopuro to explain more about Ventopuro:

Tell us a little about Ventopuro and how it fits into the Matetic family.

Ventopuro is a brand that cares about environmental and social well-being. We are developing three different projects that reflect each different range. We have a bottle recycling project, a barrel recycling project and a reforestation project. Matetic, is focused 100% on sustainability working with organic and biodynamic agriculture to protect the health of our soil and our workers.

You work in some very diverse terroir.

We choose terroirs depending on where the variety is best grown. For example for Pinot Noir, we choose a cool-climate area close to the ocean, with not much temperature difference between night and day to ensure that we have a controlled maturation. On the other hand, we grow Cabernet Sauvignon in hotter areas in order to achieve the maturation that these grape needs to give us a first-class wine.

Which regions are most exciting for you at the moment?

We love Itata for Pinot Noir as we grow some very old vines there, close to the ocean and with an excellent terroir for the variety. Another is Casablanca and San Antonio, where we grow our Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay to obtain wines with great natural acidity and crispness.

How would you describe the Ventopuro winemaking style? Obviously the terroir will differ but is there a signature characteristic we could identify in all of your wines?

We look for fruit-driven wines, with controlled oak maturation, aiming to reflect the terroir as much as possible.

You are committed to sustainability in lots of different ways - is this something that you believe wine consumers are now expecting from producers and are they prepared to pay for it?

It's a trend that's going to be a must in the coming years, and the new generations will for sure pay those extra cents to support sustainable farming and winemaking.

How do you think the Ventopuro winemaking style has evolved since 2016 ... and how do you think the wines of Chile as a whole have changed in that time?

We've been trying to make easier-drinking and fruit-driven wines to adapt to new consumer trends. Chilean wines can be found all around the globe and you will probably see a big trend to lighter, lower alcohol, and easy-drinking wines.

Which grape varieties do you have the most success with, and which ones do you think might have the most potential for the Ventopuro range?

We've had great success with the Pinot Noir Reserva. We have a great potential here since we have old vines and a story to tell behind this DO that is becoming famous for being one of the oldest winegrowing regions in Chile.

How have the wines been received in the UK market?

Excellently. Sales are growing year by year. As well as offering excellent quality for the price, the brand is innovative, and consumers appreciate it.

Roughly 1/3 of all French wine is made in the Languedoc region.

France is a country with a rich winemaking tradition, and its wines are considered some of the finest in the world. With the historic and powerful wines from Bordeaux, the elegant and extremely expensive wines from Bourgogne to the finest sparkling wines of the world in Champagne there is plenty of history and wine to discover.

Among the many wine regions in France, Languedoc stands out for its diversity and quality. Languedoc is located in the south of France and is one of the largest wine-producing regions in the world. It stretches from the Mediterranean coast to the foothills of the Pyrenees and encompasses a wide range of terroirs and micro-climates.

The region is known for producing a wide variety of wines, from crisp whites to full-bodied reds, and everything in between. A delicate balance between floral, herbal, wild red fruit (not overly ripe), stone fruit and acid. Enticing aromatics of peach, white cherry and wild raspberry that are balanced by summer flowers, white tea and Provence herbs.

The wine is a blend of Grenache (32%), Syrah (23%) and Cinsault (17%), with smaller amounts of Cabernet Sauvignon, Rolle, Grenache Blanc and Counoise in the mix. Bieler Pere et Fils, with Charles Bieler at the helm, has been making new plantings and grafting over extensively in the past 10 years. This has given it a rich selection of varieties, which is an important element in Bieler's ambition to develop and enhance the flavour profile of the wines.

2022 was warm and dry, giving the wine impressive concentration of flavour, with no loss of natural freshness. This is thanks to the fruit being sourced from the cooler, higher altitude vineyards that surround Aix-en-Provence. Here, because of the brisker night-time temperatures, the ripening period is that bit longer, which gives the grapes time to develop a broader flavour profile, while retaining natural acidity. On average, the fruit for Bieler's rosé wines is harvested two weeks after the vineyards on the flatter Provençal plains.

Charles' lifelong passion for rosé is now decades deep. At a time when rosé was slightly unfashionable, he crossed the USA in a pink Cadillac promoting the Routas rosé, building a loyal fanbase.

Bieler believes that Provence sets the gold standard in rosé wine. He says: "Our goal is to find the delicate balance between floral, herbal, wild red fruit (not overly ripe), stone fruit and acidity. We don't want singular big flavours; we want more nuance, energy, soul and Sabine 2022 has aromas of peach, white cherry and wild raspberry, balanced by summer flowers, white tea and Provençal herbs. Both delicate and creamy on the palate, this rosé has terrific length, the raspberry, cherry, herbal, citrus and mineral notes lingering long and generously.

The most popular grape Sangiovese is planted in 10% of all vineyards in Italy and translates to 'Blood of Jupiter'.



The Italian word for wine, vino, comes from the Sanskrit word "venas", which translates to love. It's also where the name "Venus", the Roman goddess of love, comes from. We like to think these two words go together quite well.

Italy is a fascinating wine country, with a rich history, diverse regions, and a wide variety of grapes and styles. One of the most iconic Italian grapes is Sangiovese, which is grown primarily in Tuscany and is the main grape variety used in the production of Chianti and Brunello di Montalcino. The wines made from Sangiovese are known for their bright red fruit flavours and high acidity. Another popular grape variety from the north of Italy is Nebbiolo, grown in the Piedmont region, which is known for its highly tannic and long-lived wines, like Barolo and Barbaresco.

Moving to the south, Aglianico is a grape variety that is mostly grown in the Campania region and is known for its complex and full-bodied wines, with strong tannins. Nero d'Avola is another southern grape variety that is mostly grown in Sicily, it's known for its rich and spicy flavours, and good structure. Lastly, there is Primitivo known for its high alcohol content, and strong fruity flavour.

Rinomata Cantina Tombacco

For more than 100 years the Tombacco family has been producing and bottling wines with genuine and intense flavours, following Italian wine-making traditions. And, the wines it procures are key Italian classics.

The Rinomata Cantina Tombacco (Renowned Tombacco Winery) was founded in 1919 and is based in Trebaseleghe, a rural town just a few kilometres away from Padua, Venice and Treviso. Tradition and quality is key for Tombacco which works with producers across Italy to create ranges which celebrate the diversity of the country and its regions.

Today, Cristian Tombacco is at the helm, working alongside his father and brother Andrea.

Ever had a wine that came in a concrete bottle before?

Nether had we until we found the extraordinary Le Argille Cabernet Di Cabernet from 47 Anno Domini Vineyards - a 50/50 blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc from Treviso, Italy.

A serious bottle such as this merits a serious wine and Le Argille does not disappoint - the winemaker calls this 'a strong, serious and unique wine'. Le Argille is aged in cement for two years which keeps the wine immaculate and free of aromatic interference (ie, from a barrel) ensuring its uniqueness and its warm, elegant and mature flavour remains intact.

This outstanding wine is the result of a wise coupage of Cabernet grapes obtained through the Double Reasoned Maturation (DMR) technique, which is applied directly in the vineyard. This technique consists of clamping select branches before the grapes reach a complete maturation. This means the grapes start to age while still on the vine resulting in a greater concentration of sugar giving more structure and strength to the wine.

The wine is aged into cement vats for 24 months, after that the winery team performs a sensory test to decide when the best time to bottle is. After which the wine is then aged further for at least 6 months.



Le Argille is aged in concrete for two years

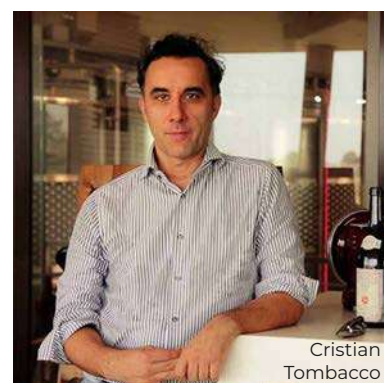

Do you know the legend of the Gallo Nero?

You'll notice the Chianti Classico bottles above have a black rooster on the cap - this is The Gallo Nero, the historic symbol of the League of Chianti and has become the symbol of Chianti Classico.

This symbol is linked to a medieval legend that takes place during the time of open hostilities between Florence and Siena for control of the Chianti territory. In order to finally define political boundaries between the two cities, it was decided that two knights would depart from their respective cities at sunrise and fix the boundary at the point where they met. The rooster's crow at dawn was the signal for the knights to start riding. The Sienese opted for a white rooster; the Florentines chose a black rooster.

The Florentines kept their rooster in a small, dark chicken-coop and did not feed it for days. On the day of the ride, once the black rooster was freed, it began to crow well ahead of dawn, allowing for the Florentine knight to depart well in advance of the Sienese knight. Thanks to his considerable head start, the Florentine knight met his opponent only 12 km from the point of departure of the Sienese knight. This allowed Florence to keep control of nearly the entirety of the Chianti territory.

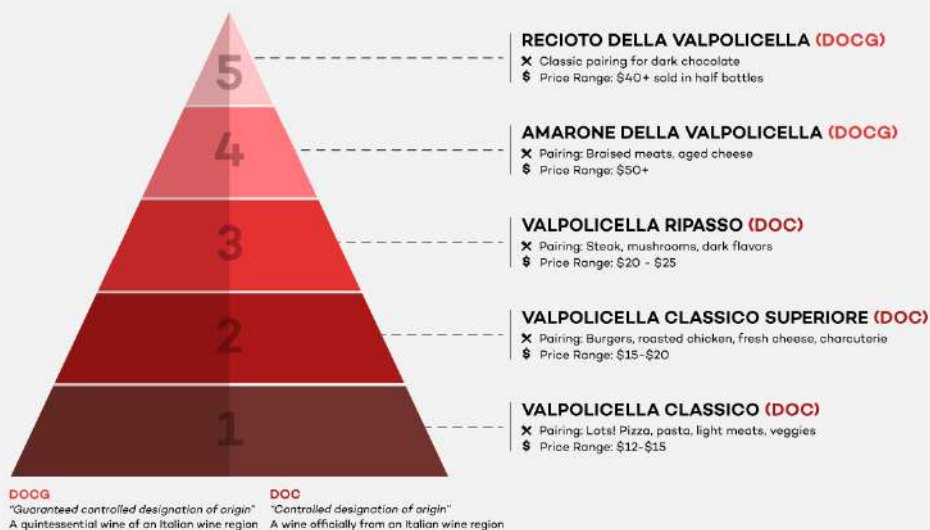

Due to its location, New Zealand's vineyards are the first on our planet to see the sun each day. And, also some of the first vineyards to be harvested every year.

The wines of New Zealand are some of the best in the world. Despite its size, New Zealand has a thriving wine industry and is known for producing high-quality wines, particularly Sauvignon Blanc. The country's cool climate and diverse terroir also allow for a variety of wine styles to be produced, including Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, and Riesling. The wine industry in New Zealand is relatively young, with the first vineyards being planted in the late 1800s. However, it has rapidly gained recognition on the world stage, with New Zealand wines winning numerous awards and receiving critical acclaim.

Until the 1980's Müller-Thurgau was dominating the vineyards of New Zealand. But because of lower demand and higher risk of diseases the vineyards were rebuilt with new vines. From this day the New Zealand wines we now know started. Most winemakers planted Sauvignon Blanc, which is now dominating around 72% of the vineyards in New Zealand. The number one region of Sauvignon is Marlborough and, today three quarters of New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc is planted in Marlborough making it one of the most important regions in the world when speaking of Sauvignon Blanc.

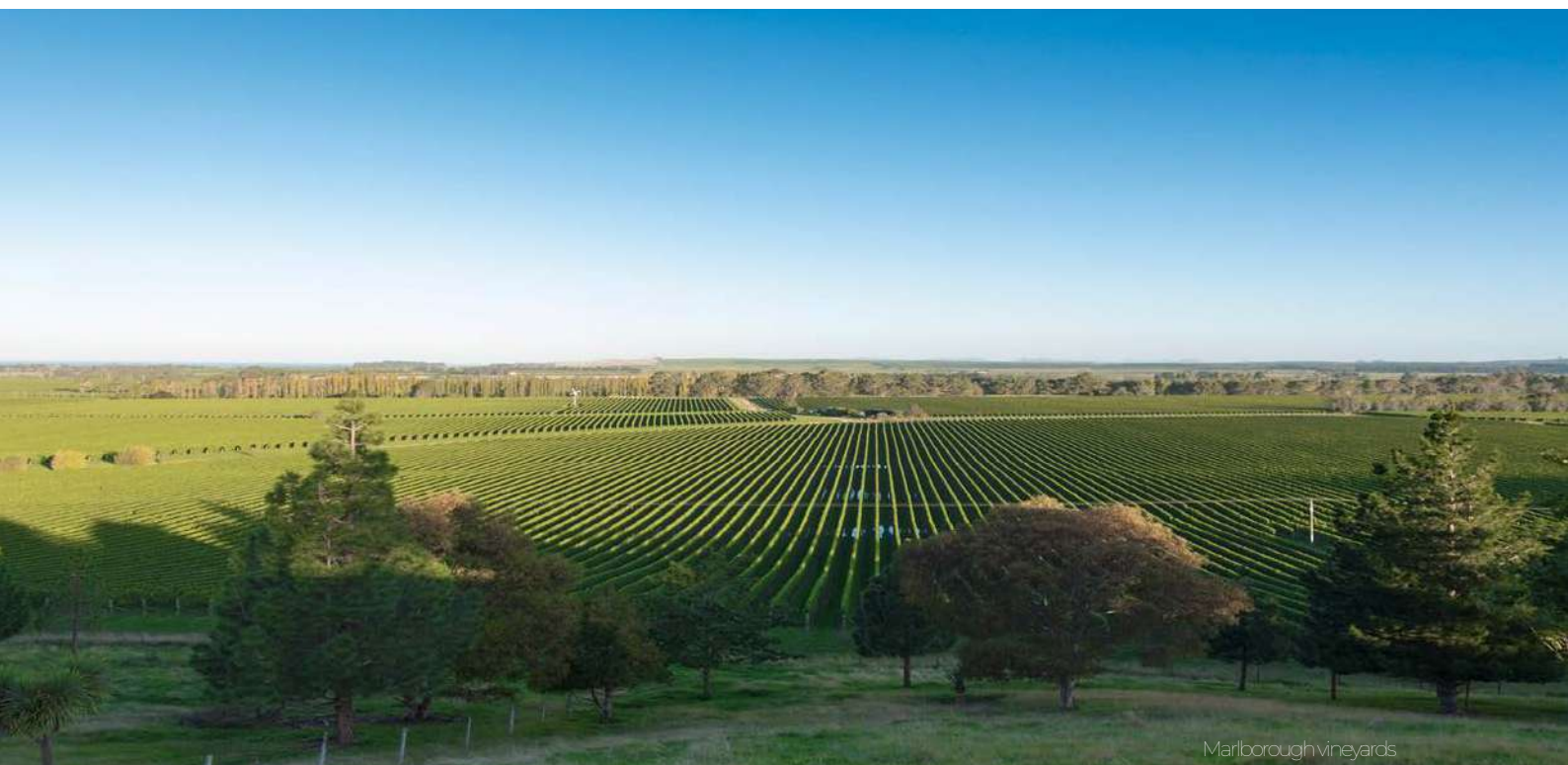

The city of Blenheim is at the region's heart, and is just a short 20 minute drive from the breath-taking beauty of the Marlborough Sounds. Douro is the oldest demarcated and regulated wine region in the world, declared in 1756 and made a UNESCO World Heritage site in 2001.



Portugal has more than 250 native grape varieties and the highest density of indigenous grapes per square mile of any country in the world



Portugal is the largest producer of corks in the world with just about half of total global production, equivalent to around 100 tonnes every year.

Portuguese wine is a delicious and fascinating journey through history and terroir. The country's wine industry has deep roots dating back to the Roman Empire and continues to evolve and innovate today. From the rolling hills of the Douro Valley, where port wine is produced, to the coastal region of Vinho Verde, where crisp white wines are made, Portuguese wines offer a diverse range of flavours and styles that are sure to delight any wine lover.

The best-known Portuguese wine is Port Wine, which is made from a blend of grape varieties, with the most common being Touriga Nacional, Tinta Roriz, and Tinta Barroca. The wine is fortified with brandy, which stops the fermentation process and leaves a natural sweetness in the wine.

Port was originally created as a way to preserve wine during the long sea voyage from Portugal to England. The addition of brandy helped to stabilise the wine and protect it from spoilage. Port is typically aged in wooden casks, which helps to develop its complex flavours. Some Ports can be aged for decades, and are considered some of the finest and most sought-after wines in the world.

PORTO & DOURO WINES

VALLEGRE IS OWNED BY A FAMILY DEEPLY ROOTED IN THE DOURO REGION, SO IT'S NO SURPRISE THAT TRADITION IS A MAJOR PART OF THE COMPANY ETHOS.

Quinta da Vista Alegre

For Vallegrre, progress and development are just as important as the traditions handed down from each generation. The company is thriving because it recognises the need to evolve and operate sustainably. General manager Miguel Martins describes Vallegrre as “family-based and modern”. He says the “dynamism, creativity and innovation” so integral to the company is achieved “without forgetting the knowledge passed on from generation to generation”.

Making wine since the 19th century, Vallegrre is now a fifth-generation family business, and its main focus continues to be the production of DOC wines, specifically DOC Porto, DOC Douro and DOC Moscatel do Douro. The wines are sold and enjoyed in almost 40 countries and have earned many trophies and accolades over the years and although port is still its main output, its specialism in still wines continues to grow at pace.

Vallegrre comprises three estates in the heart of the Douro: Quinta da Vista Alegre in Pinhão, Quinta de Valle Longo in Cima Corgo and Quinta da Lameira in Baixo Corgo. This is mountain viticulture at its best, so pruning and harvesting must be done by hand. In a landscape that's both magnificent and wildly challenging, it's essential to operate sustainably. The winery has put many water saving and collection measures in place in case irrigation ever becomes a necessity. Martins say he has never had to do this in the past, preferring to stress the vines. But the effects of climate change might one day force him and his team to think differently one day soon.

In addition to irrigation, planting of mixed legume seeds has already begun – a practice that improves the soil's nutrient content and benefits pollinators. Sustainable practices also include plans for the installation of solar panels, and a considerable reduction of plastic packaging in favour of cardboard, which in turn is chosen very carefully.

Romania is the fifth largest wine producing country in Europe, although its wines are still largely unknown amongst British wine drinkers. With 3000 hectares, Fetească Neagră, or black maiden, is Romania's favourite indigenous red grape and second most-planted dark-berried variety behind Merlot (11,901 hectares). Depending on climate and vintage, it can produce medium- to full-bodied wines.

Recaş Wineries (Romanian: Cramele Recaş) is a winery located in Recaş, Timiş County, Romania.

Established in 1991, the company was Romania's leading wine producer by 2018, with a turnover of €38 million. Additionally, it was the country's top exporter, sending half its output abroad.[1]

The winery has an annual production capacity of 32 million liters. Its grapes grow on 1150 hectares in Recaş and Miniş. The grapes are in 25 varieties, producing 45 brands.

An interesting aspect of South African wine is its use of "bush vines". These are grapevines that are grown without the use of trellising or support systems and are trained to grow along the ground. This method of growing grapes is unique to South Africa and is used primarily in the production of dry land wines, particularly in the regions of Swartland and the Eastern Cape. The use of bush vines results in lower yields but the grapes that are produced are known for their intense flavour and concentration. The wines produced from bush vines are known for their complexity and character and are highly sought after by wine enthusiasts.

Spain is home to 13% of the world's total vineyards making it the world's largest producer by area, but only third by volume.



More than 60% of all Cava produced in Spain is exported.



Rioja wine has four categories, based on age: Genérico, Crianza, Reserva, and Gran Reserva.

Spanish wines are known for their complexity, depth, and character. They offer a diverse range of styles and flavours, from the rich, full-bodied reds of Rioja and Ribera del Duero to the crisp, refreshing whites of Rueda and Galicia. The country's fortified wines, such as Sherry, are also world-renowned for their complex flavours and long aging potential.

Like many other countries, the heat was extreme in vintage 2022 and a new heat record was set in Spain. This meant that harvest in some places started as early as late July. It is expected that vineyards with coastal influence or higher altitudes will perform better as they often are cooler than other vineyards.

When phylloxera hit in the 1860's many winemakers from Bordeaux took the first train and ended up in a small town called Haro, which is now considered to be the 'wine capital' of Rioja. When French winemakers arrived they introduced new techniques and changed winemaking in Rioja. Previously the wines of Rioja made bulk wines but the French are to thank for the amazing wines coming from this region. If you take a bottle of Bordeaux and a bottle of Rioja many of the same characteristics will show, often making it difficult to differentiate the wines in blind tastings.

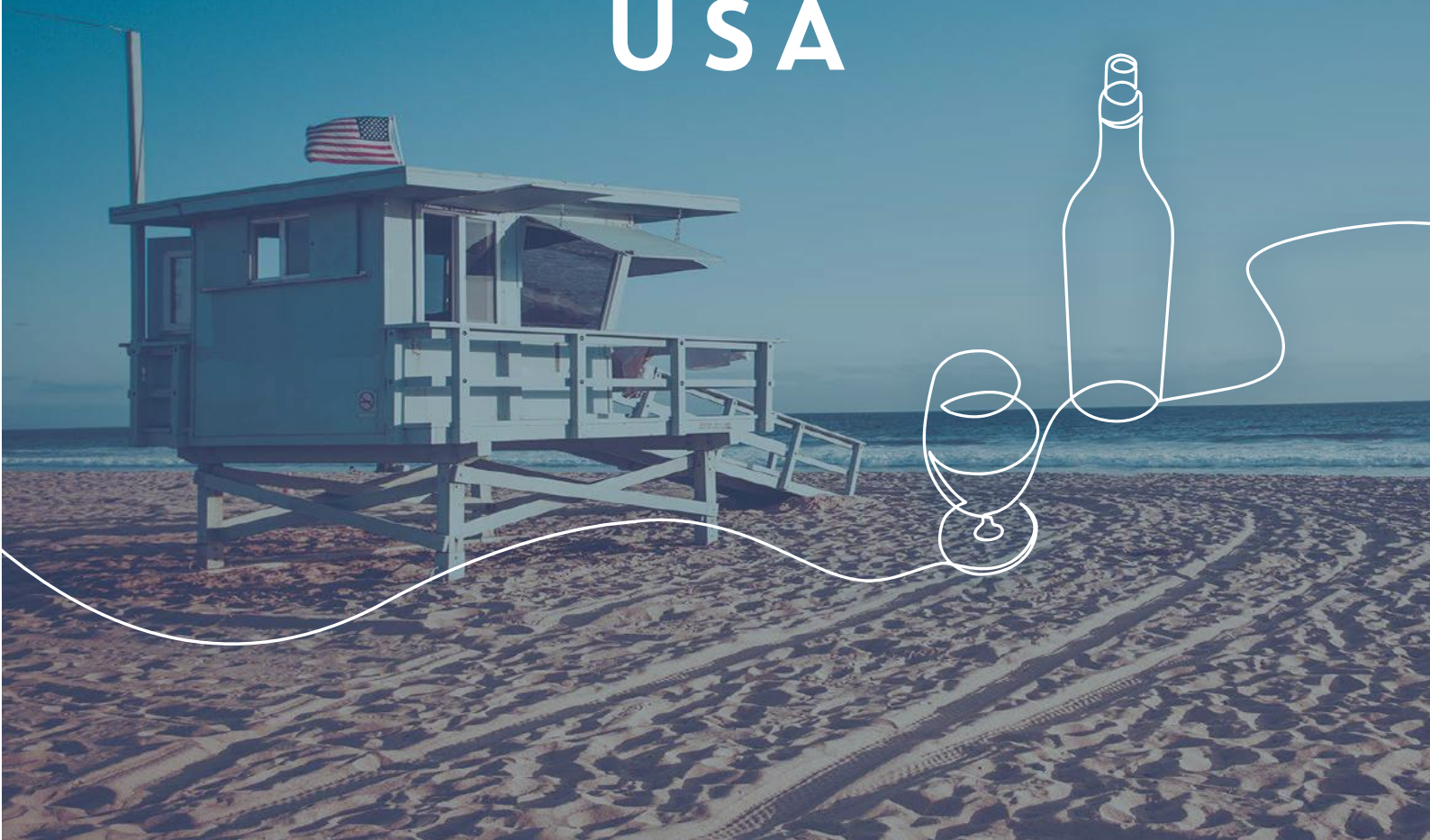

The USA is the fourth largest producer of wine in the world but even without other regions California could be the fourth largest producer itself.



Zinfandel is considered a California "heritage" grape and is grown in more acreage than any other varietal. Zinfandel is also known as Primitivo in Italy.



White Zinfandel was invented in California in the 1970s.

California wine is the pride and joy of the Golden State! Known for its sunny climate and diverse terroir, California produces some of the most delicious and sought-after wines in the world. From Napa Valley's famous Cabernet Sauvignon to Sonoma's lush Chardonnay, California's wine regions offer a diverse range of flavours and styles to suit every palate.

One fun fact about California wine is that it has a long history dating back to the 18th century when Spanish missionaries planted the first vines in the state. Today, California is the fourth largest wine-producing region in the world, and it is home to over 4,000 wineries.

The popularity of Californian wine exploded in 1976 when Steven Spurrier arranged the Judgement of Paris. The competition pitted California wines against French wines in a blind tasting, with a panel of French judges. The goal was to determine which wines were the best and to see how California wines stacked up against their French counterparts.

The competition was a major shock to the wine world as the results revealed that the California wines had come out on top, with the 1973 Chateau Montelena Chardonnay and the 1973 Stag's Leap Wine Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon winning in their respective categories. The results caused a sensation, challenging the long-held belief that only French wines could be truly great, and it marked a turning point in the world of wine.

It's creamy and full-bodied on the palate, perfectly balanced by bright acidity and a crisp, refreshing finish. Malolactic fermentation then time on oak which imparts notes of spice.

Since the first grapes were planted in the state 50 years ago, Oregon has become recognised as one of the world's elite winemaking regions.

With 22 designated wine growing areas located in five diverse regions, Oregon now boasts more than 793 wineries producing wine from over 82 grape varieties.

The state has a varied climate and unique terroirs. Most of its wineries are small and family owned, many producing fewer than 5,000 cases annually. They can be found sprinkled along country roads, tucked into mountain foothills, situated high above vineyards with breath-taking views of the landscape.

Oregon's northerly latitude means grapes get extra growing season sunlight for long, even ripening, combined with crisp, cool nights to help grapes retain their freshening acidity.



Joel Gott

Joel Gott, the founder of Joel Gott Wines, is a fifth-generation vintner, a lover of great food, an entrepreneur and an athlete. Born into a family of California vintners—his grandfather ran Inglenook Winery in the 60s, and his father founded Montevina Winery in the 70s—Joel grew up in the vineyards and learned to drive a tractor before he could legally drive a car.

For his Oregon wine range, Joel hand selects fruit from Oregon's Willamette Valley, where the region's cool climate stresses the vines, creating smaller, more concentrated fruit clusters that yield more complex, flavourful wines.

Joel is also one of the Three Thieves (page 90) and visitors to Northern California are likely to have eaten in one of his Gott's Roadside Diners.

Joel Gott Pinot Gris 2021

Willamette Valley, Oregon

Aromas of honeydew melon and lime with notes of pear and peach blossoms. On the palate, the wine opens with bright acidity and citrus notes followed by a smooth, elongated mid-palate with tropical fruit flavours and a long, clean balanced finish. A long, cool fermentation in stainless steel tanks preserved the varietal characteristics of the fruit.

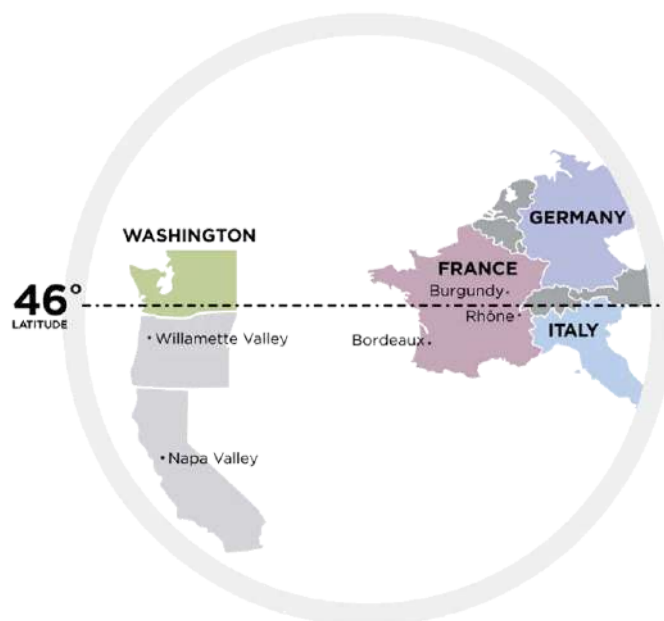


USA - WASHINGTON STATE

Washington State is the second-largest wine region in the United States. The state has 16 unique AVAs (American Viticultural Areas), each possessing a unique combination of climate, topography and soils that define the aromas and flavours of locally grown grapes and the wines crafted from them. Washington's growers and vintners work in tandem to produce a combination of old world and new world styles spanning over 70 grape varieties.

Washington has the perfect climate for growing wine grapes, sharing the same latitude as other famous wine regions in Europe including Burgundy and the Rhône. This 46° parallel is the sweet spot for growing grapes as it receives the most amount of sunlight during the growing season.

The state has a magical balance of heat and continentality that provides a contrast of ripeness with preserved acidity. The cool nights keep the wines of Washington fragrant and fresh.



The Charles & Charles range is a collaboration founded in 2008 between Charles Smith (K Vintners, Charles Smith Wines) and Charles Bieler (Three Thieves, Bieler Père et Fils).

Charles Bieler had a dream to make world-class rosé in Washington State and called his good friend, Charles Smith. From here, the Charles and Charles legacy was born.

When Charles met Charles they both commented it was unusual to find two 'Charles' - the name 'Charles' is usually shortened to Charlie, Chuck or Chaz in America - so commemorated the brand with their names.

The iconic Charles and Charles Stars & Stripes label is a nod towards the American Legion Post No. 35 building in Waitsburg, WA (north of Walla Walla). Charles Smith bought this building and painted it to create a conceptual art piece, its intention is to provoke thought about the future while honouring the past.



Charles and Charles Rosé 2020/22

Columbia Valley, Washington State

Pale salmon colour, copper pink with flashes of Fuchsia. An aromatic nose of raspberries and cherry, a light but dynamic palate with a tangy bright finish. All of the fruit is grown above 1,100 feet, which may not sound that high, but in Washington only 10% of the total vineyards planted are above that level. This elevation ensures gentle ripening and natural acidity.

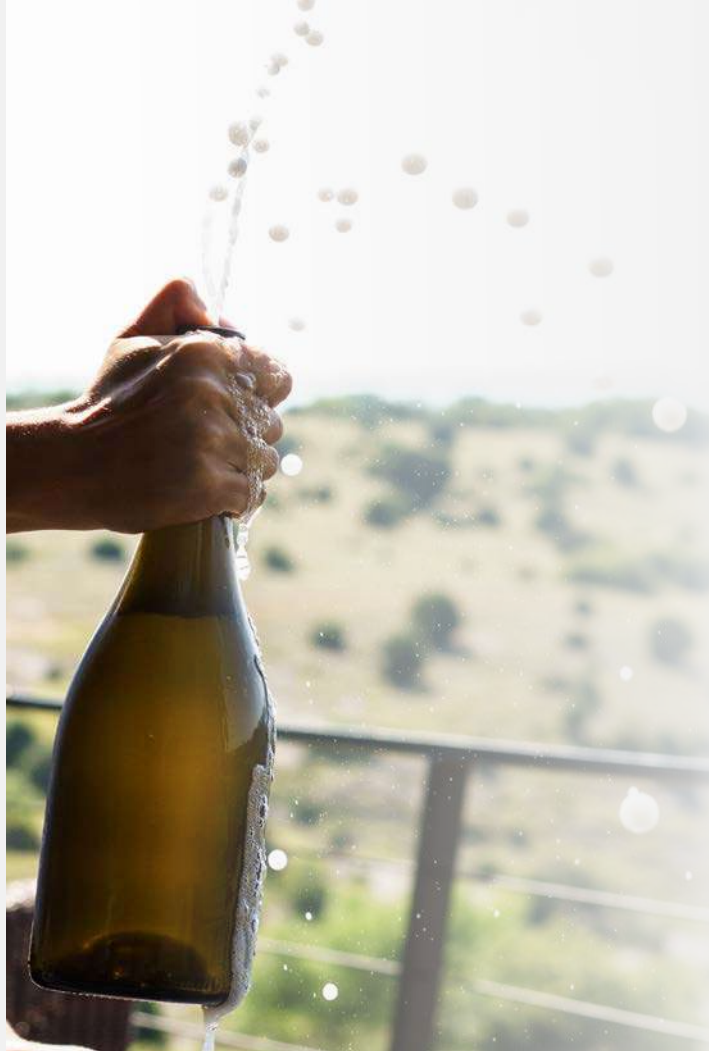

Pet Nat (short for Pétillant-Naturel) is a type of sparkling wine that is made using the ancestral method, which is the oldest method for making sparkling wine.

It is a natural sparkling wine that is made by bottling the wine before fermentation is complete, allowing the fermentation to finish in the bottle, which creates natural carbonation.

Pet Nat wine is made from grapes that are harvested at an earlier stage of ripeness than those used for traditional sparkling wine, which gives it a lower alcohol content and a lighter, fresher flavour profile. The wine is bottled with the yeast still active, and the fermentation process continues in the bottle, creating carbon dioxide, which gives the wine its effervescence.

Because the fermentation process is less controlled than with other methods of making sparkling wine, the resulting wine can have a range of flavours and textures, from fruity and floral to yeasty and funky. Pet Nat wines are often unfiltered and may have a cloudy appearance due to the presence of yeast sediment in the bottle.

Pet Nat wines have gained popularity in recent years as a natural, artisanal alternative to traditional sparkling wines.

PÉT' MOUT'

The Moutard family is one of the leading Champagne producers (see next page). Several years ago the family purchased a domaine in Burgundy and began producing a range of interesting offerings, including Pétillant-Naturel - and the Pet' Mout' range was born!

The wines are produced according to Methode Ancestrale - a traditional method of making sparkling wine that is, in fact, the world's most ancient. The wine is bottled before the primary fermentation is finished, delivering a lower pressure,

lightly sparkling wine in the pétillant style. The wine is finished without the addition of secondary yeasts, sugars, or sulphites. Grapes used for both of these wines are sustainably farmed and harvested from the Area of Tonnerre, which is close to Chablis in Burgundy.

So, what's this got to do with the flatulent sheep on the label? The name is a play on words: it *could* be an abbreviation of Pétillant Moutard, or an alternative is Péter Mouton (French dictionaries at the ready!). Even serious wine can have a bit of fun.



CHAMPAGNE MOUTARD



The Moutard family has been making wine since 1642 from its base in Buxeuil on the sunny slopes of the Côte des Bar and started producing Champagne in 1927 when Lucien Moutard took over the family vineyards.

Lucien learned the art of farming the local land from his father, Paul, something he passed on to his children: Agnès, Véronique and François who today run the company. And, they have been joined in the business by their sons: Thomas, Edouard, Alexandre, Benoit and Victor (familiarily nicknamed 'the boys') making this a true family business! Importantly, the Moutard family respects its ancestral land. The family's know-how is in keeping with tradition and consideration for the vineyards' ecosystem in order to ensure handcrafted and sustainable viticulture.

Did you know...

The Spanish word cava means "cave" or "cellar", as caves were used in the early days of cava production for the preservation or aging of wine.

Spanish winemakers officially adopted the term 'Cava' in 1970 to distinguish their product from French Champagne.

Cava is a sparkling wine which originates from Catalonia, a region in north-eastern Spain. It is made using the same traditional method as Champagne, known as the méthode champenoise or traditional method.

It is typically produced from a blend of three grape varieties: Macabeo, Parellada, and Xarel·lo, although other local grape varieties such as Chardonnay and Pinot Noir can also be used. The production process involves a second fermentation that occurs in the bottle, resulting in the characteristic bubbles of the wine.

Cava comes in different styles ranging from dry to sweet, with varying levels of sweetness labelled as Brut Nature, Extra Brut, Brut, Extra Seco, Seco, Semiseco, or Dulce. It is known for its crisp acidity, fruity flavours, and a wide range of aromas including citrus, apple, floral, and nutty notes.

Cava is a popular choice for celebrations and is often served as an apéritif or paired with a variety of dishes, including seafood, poultry, and light appetisers. It has gained international recognition and is enjoyed by wine enthusiasts around the world.

1. Payment of Account

Payment must be made before the 15th of the month following the date on the Invoice. All payments to be addressed to Lanchester Wines.

2. Overdue Accounts

Accounts overdue will be charged at 4% interest per month after warning in writing has been given. Any represented cheques will be charged at £10.00 per presentation.

3. Title

Notwithstanding delivery and the passing of the risk in the Goods or any other provision of these Conditions the property in the Goods shall not pass to the Buyer until the Seller has received in cash or cleared funds payment in full of the price of the goods and all other goods agreed to be sold by the Seller to the Buyer for which payment is then due.

Until such time as the property in the Goods passes to the Buyer the Buyer shall hold the Goods as Sellers fiduciary Agent and Bailee and shall keep the Goods separate from those of the Buyer and third parties and properly stored, protected and insured and identified as the Seller's property. Until that time the Buyer shall be entitled to re-sell for the proceeds of the sale or otherwise of the goods, whether tangible or intangible, including insurance proceeds, and shall keep such proceeds separate from any monies or property of the Buyer and third parties and, in the case of tangible proceeds, properly stored, protected and insured.

Until such time as the property and the goods passes to the buyer (and provided the goods are still in existence and have not been re-sold) the seller shall be entitled at any time to require the Buyer to deliver up the Goods to the Seller and if the Buyer fails to do so, forthwith to enter upon any premises of the Buyer or any third party where the Goods are stored and repossess the Goods.

4. Claims

All goods must be examined on collection, signed for and any damages or partial losses noted against such signature. Claims for loss or breakage to be telephoned to us on the day goods are received and confirmed in writing with photographic evidence to ourselves within three days of the receipt of the goods.

8. Value Added Tax
